

Minutes of the Tri Annual Meeting held on Monday, August 1, 2016 at 6:29 pm at the New Lenox Community Park District, New Lenox, IL.

GENERAL FUNCTIONS:

Call to order Director Travnicek of Parks-Maintenance - called the August 1, 2016 meeting to order at approximately 6:29 pm.

Chris Vetor/Matt Erickson- NL Rebels Baseball

Chris Vetor reported no major projects at time. Mr. Vetor extended his thanks to the New Lenox Park District for their work all season. The field are in great shape. Fall registration is higher than last year at this point reported by Chris Vetor. The Mustang level has increased; surpassed 200 it looks like five teams this year for the Mustang level. Season starts after Labor Day.

Greg Cleveland NLGSA

Mr. Cleveland reported summer season went fine except for a few parking issues. First Travel teams went to Kankakee for first tournaments; represented the team well. For fall season there are 265 participants for fall league, which is approximately 20 teams. Mr. Cleveland mentioned practices begin end of August and games start after Labor Day. Mr. Cleveland reported Travel teams went well and Fall Travel team tryouts are soon. One of the requirements for joining the Travel team—their Rec (house) league always come first. Mr. Cleveland is stepping down as of September 2016 and Mrs. Kurth will be the new President of the NLGSA. Mr. Cleveland noted about Bob Schaper on the procession and great speeches of how wonderful he was.

Lynn Plarski - NL Mustangs

Sad news for the NL Mustangs family this year with the passing of Mr. Bob Schaper; his sister Lynn Plarski was very appreciative of all the respect and appreciation of her brother and of all the support from the community and members of the organization. Registration began last week of July and as of this meeting date there were 225 members signed up for football and 121 cheerleaders. Lynn stated that her son is stepping in to help the organization. First game is Saturday, August 20th at Martino Jr. High and the first practice is being held August 1, 2016. They had their annual golf outing where they awarded 11 different kids \$16,000.00 Lynn Plarski discussed parking issues and expressed her interest again with having lines painted to avoid parkers illegally parking and to keep gate area open for emergencies. Lynn Plarski also reported some lights concerns that are out at the field and would like the truck to come out and replace them before the first game. Kevin Shannon NLSA

Mr. Shannon reported 460 participants for Spring league, Spring Picnic went well-everything turned out great. Mr. Shannon thanked Director of Parks-Maintenance Travnicek for a job well done with the picnic. This Fall is down about 100 mostly on 12 u level. Coaches meeting August 2nd, will stress parking issues. Talked about new projects for this year; one being lights for the shed to see the equipment inside. Planning on looking into a solar solution for the time being, because the distance is pretty significance from the building. Also, some benches need to be

repaired and some replacing of sod. Mr. Shannon is talking about some Winter indoor playing time at Spencer (things are just in the beginning planning stages).

Director of Parks-Maintenance Travnicek reported and thanked how well the staff worked the Proud American Days. A few issues with Out of District fees; fees will go towards equipment and buying of a new in field groomer for softball and baseball. Also, we are in need for a new paint striper.
