Boxes 3 & 5 had extra drainage work completed but overall our golf course is doing great. Commissioner Kraemer gave Golf Course Superintendent Eggert kudos and his staff for maintaining and keeping up with the greens; and Director of Golf Schulz's staff is doing great job in the clubhouse. Director of Golf Schulz explained the slide show pictures to the Board and public, the biggest thing was the drainage was fixed in the practice bunkers and was done in house. Director of Golf Schulz also commented that the gaming is going to be taxing more but the bets are higher and the payouts are better. We can actually add an additional machine.

## <u>Development Projects Update</u>

Commissioner Larson explained to the public how the Park District receives funding to build our parks. Commissioner Larson noted Bristol Park had sink holes which was caused 180 lineal feet of farmer's drain title that was falling apart. Commissioner Larson noted Sky Harbor is the next possible OSLAD grant site. It was noted staff has been trying to keep up with mowing but with it being so wet they can only do so much, please be patient. Executive Director Lewis gave a shout out to Will County Stormwater Management for help us out with Bristol Park and helping fund our sink hole issues. We received up to 10K in assistance. It was also reported that NuWay Disposal will be our new vendor beginning October 1st.

Director of Parks-Maintenance Travnicek noted staff has been busy with athletic field work continues and laying down safety mulch in the playground.
