Rules and Regulations

- 1. Splash Pad Capacity: 50 People
- 2. Temperature checks required upon entry.
- 3. Face coverings must be worn when not engaged in water activities.
- 4. Adhere to social distancing where applicable.
- 5. Wash your hands or use hand sanitizer whenever possible.
- 6. All children under the age of 10 must have adult supervision at all times.
- 7. All persons using the Splash Pad do so at their own risk and sole responsibility.
- 8. Swimsuits and/or appropriate attire must be worn at all times. 9. All non-toilet trained babies must wear swim diapers.
- 10. All participants must conduct themselves in a courteous, safe and familyoriented manner.
- 11.Do not hang, swing or pull on any of the Splash Pad equipment. 12. Food and/or beverages of any kind are not allowed in Splash Pad.
- 13. Absolutely NO glass containers or breakable objects allowed.
- 14. No smoking. 15. No sand allowed in Splash Pad.
- 16. No skateboards, roller blades, bicycles or scooters allowed.
- 17.Dogs/pets are not allowed in the Splash Pad area.
- 18. The Park District is not responsible for any lost or damaged personal items. 19. If temperature drops below 74° or lightning is spotted, the Splash Pad will
- close. 20. Please vacate the park when conditions call for thunder or lightning.
