Your Parks Maintenance Department strives to keep your parks and athletic sites clean, safe and accessible for all. They continue to renovate older shelters, replace older site furniture and seal coat walking paths and parking lots.

Our newly renovated Disc Golf Course at Haines Park is open and ready for you to play! Sign up for the 19th New Lenox Disc Golf Open in June. Did you know that U.S. House of Representatives has designated July as Parks and Recreation Month. In honor of the this, we are celebrating with our official Grand Opening of Sky Harbor Park on July 27. Don't forget to sign up your family for an enjoyable afternoon.

We are so excited we are beginning construction on Hibernia Park Phase II this summer, although most of the park amenities will be closed, you will be able to use the walking path and the pond for fishing. The new development has a project budget of just over \$1 million. Hibernia Park Phase II is funded by the OSLAD grant and the New Lenox Community Park District. When OSLAD grants are awarded, agencies typically exceed the dollar-for-dollar minimum matching requirement. On average, local agencies match the state's dollar investment by \$1.75, meaning that the state receives 175% of its investment.

In closing, I speak for myself and my fellow commissioners when I say we are excited to see all our upcoming park projects come to fruition. We look forward to enhancing the parks and recreation experience to the New Lenox Community!

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

- Children must be the correct age by 9/1/23, unless otherwise specified. In order to provide your child with the best possible recreational and/or learning experience, all our programs are planned according to the ages listed in our Program Guide.
- · Although your child may turn the correct age during the session of a program, our age requirement date coincides with the school district's date to assist with the fundamental growth of the child in the age-appropriate programs and therefore would not be eligible for registration.
- Classes are for the registered child only, except for classes with an adult. Parents should not remain in the classroom or gymnasium after dropping off their child. This is in the child's best interest, as continual interruptions tend to affect participants' attention span and inhibit the establishment of peer relationships.
- All children must be potty-trained unless they are attending a class where an adult stays with them or is otherwise stated in the class description. Diapers are not permitted in independent classes unless stated in the class description.
- Please do not bring food to any class unless previously arranged.
- For your child's safety, all children enrolled in programs must be picked up from the specific classroom or program site by their parent(s) or designated guardian. No child will be released from the classroom to anyone other than individuals from the pick-up list.
- A mandatory sign-in and sign-out procedure for all participants is required for all Park District Programs. Children must be accompanied by an adult when escorted to and from class.

REFUND POLICY

No refunds are given: (1) once a program begins unless a replacement is found; (2) on material fees unless we cancel a program; (3) on bus trips; or (4) for special events or one-day programs. A full refund is issued if we cancel a program or trip.

- When a participant cancels out of a program, a full refund, less a \$5 service charge (per program), will be granted. A \$5 service charge will also be assessed on all program transfers.
- These requests will only be honored if the request is submitted three business days prior to the start of the program or activity.
- All refunds less than \$10 will be applied as a credit to the customer's account.
- Every effort will be made to process refunds within 30 days, but in some instances it may take longer.
- New Lenox Community Park District reserves the right to change program details at any time.

CANCELLATIONS

Staff reserves the right to consolidate, postpone, reschedule, or cancel any program due to changes in day, dates, times, instructor or insufficient enrollment. If program enrollment does not meet the minimum number of registrants, we try to cancel the program seven days prior to the start date or by the registration deadline.

For cancellations due to unforeseen circumstances (i.e., inclement weather, facility emergencies or scheduling conflicts), which are announced by Lincoln-Way District 210 or New Lenox School District 122 at facilities where Park District programs are scheduled, Park District programming will be cancelled as well. All attempts will be made to reschedule cancelled classes. However, the New Lenox Community Park District is sometimes unable to accommodate make-up classes and will not refund money in such instances.

PROGRAM BEHAVIOR POLICY

Participants are expected to exhibit appropriate behavior. The following guidelines have been developed to help make Park District programs safe and enjoyable for all participants. Additional rules may be developed for programs and athletic leagues as deemed necessary by staff.

- Show respect to participants and staff and take direction from staff.
- Refrain from using abusive or foul language or from causing bodily harm to self, other participants or staff.
- Show respect to equipment, supplies and facilities. The New Lenox Community Park District reserves the right to terminate a party's participation in a Park District program due to that party's disruptive behavior or conduct.

PHOTO DISCLAIMER

Registrants and participants permit to the taking of photos and videos of themselves and their children during Park District activities for publication and use as the Park District deems necessary.

PROGRAM GUIDE DISTRIBUTION

To provide you the most up-to-date information, the Program Guides will be available online only at newlenoxparks.org. We continue to review guidelines to determine the best way to safely serve the community while fulfilling our mission of providing quality community life.

LIABILITY

The New Lenox Community Park District is unable to assume responsibility for injuries, accidents or loss of personal property occurring during programs or activities, in parks or facilities. Such insurance would make programs and user fees prohibitive.

PROGRAM INFORMATION ICONS

- Please note that for selected ticketed or special events as well as some ongoing programs, online registration is not available. Programs that do not allow online registration are shown with this icon:

AMERICAN DISABILITIES ACT (ADA)

A request for ADA modifications or assistance at a program is required at the time of registration. Please mark the ADA box on the Registration Form and call our Administration Building at (815) 485-3584. Early registration, along with a request for accommodation, is strongly suggested to assure that appropriate modifications are secured prior to the start of the program. We recommend at least four weeks' notice to have modifications in place.

REGISTRATION POLICIES

- · A government issued birth certificate is required for all participants two (2) years and younger before registration will be accepted.
- Parents/guardians may register for immediate family members only. Each adult must sign the Registration
- Phone-in registrations are not accepted.
- If there is a problem with your registration, we will contact you by phone or email. If we cannot reach you, the Registration Form will be returned by mail and your place in the program cannot be saved. Be sure to include a valid daytime phone number and e-mail on all Registration Forms.
- Registration is not complete until a printed confirmation or email receipt has been issued.
- The New Lenox Community Park District is not responsible for lost or late mail or faxes.
- All Registration Forms must be signed. Those without signatures will be returned to the sender, thereby jeopardizing registration and program placement.
- A \$25 service charge will be assessed on all rejected credit card payments for families utilizing our installment billing system and \$30 service charge on all returned checks.
- The New Lenox Community Park District reserves the right to suspend participation in activities of customers whose account is in "bad standing" until all fees are paid. Failure to pay may result in collection costs added to outstanding balances.

RESIDENT REGISTRATION (R)

Resident Registration and Online Registration will begin on Monday, May 1, at 9:00am at the Administration Building, 701 W. Haven Avenue. Registration Forms are accepted as soon as our Program Guide is posted on our website, but will not be processed until Monday, May 1, at 9:00am. Early submission of registration does not guarantee enrollment in a program.

NONRESIDENT REGISTRATION (NR)

Nonresident participants can register for New Lenox Community Park District programs beginning Monday, May 8. Additional fees for nonresidents may apply. We do not charge a nonresident fee for special events or bus trips.

REGISTRATION INFO

FIRST-TIME REGISTRATION

When registering for the first time, residents will need to provide proof of residency by showing proper documentation. Those documents include:

One Item from Category 1

- Most recent property tax bill
- Most recent mortgage statement (we do not accept mortgage coupon payment books)
- Signed and dated lease or letter from manager (on letterhead) and proof of last month's payment
- Mortgage closing statement (if you have moved in the last 30 days)

Two Items from Category 2

- Valid Illinois Driver's License or State I.D. Card
- Most recent gas, electric and/or water bill
- Most recent cable television bill, credit card bill and/or bank statement
- Voter Registration
- Vehicle Registration
- Current Public Aid Card

Nonresidents will need to provide a valid Driver's License or State I.D. Card at the time of registration.

PAYMENT

- Full payment must be paid to the New Lenox Community Park District at time of registration
- Cash, credit/debit cards or checks are acceptable forms of payment
- Checks should be made payable to New Lenox Community Park District or NLCPD
- We do not accept payments over the phone

SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

If you are (1) a New Lenox resident and (2) cannot participate for financial reasons, you may be eligible for financial aid. Please e-mail completed Financial Aid Application and supporting documentation to Olga Viano at oviano@newlenoxparks.org. All required documentation must be submitted with the completed application. Please note that the maximum household scholarship benefit is \$1,000 per year.

MILITARY DISCOUNT

We are pleased to offer a military discount for those who qualify. A Military Master Form must be filled out completely prior to receiving the military discount. For more information, please visit newlenoxparks.org/registration/.

In-District/Out-of-District Residents

EXCITING NEWS . . . WE BEGAN ADDING RECREATIONAL AMENITIES AT HIBERNIA PARK (PHASE II DEVELOPMENT) THIS SPRING.

The park's splash pad, boat rentals and playground will be CLOSED this year for the construction; however, you are able to fish and use the walking path around the pond.

We encourage the community to use the Splash Pad at Walker Country Estates Park and visit our two great new parks just south of Hibernia, Leigh Creek South and Sky Harbor.

NLCPD Receives OSLAD Grant For Hibernia Park Phase II

The New Lenox Community Park District was awarded an OSLAD Grant in the amount of \$400,000 to help update one of our most frequented parks, Hibernia Park.

Hibernia Park Phase II will feature an expanded boat dock along with an ADA accessible kayak station to better serve all members of our community. The open space between the current concession area and park will soon be home to a boardwalk over a pollinator prairie to allow for a more accessible walkway to our park and splash pad, this will also serve as a fun learning experience for all. The splash pad will be made larger with new equipment and a slip resistant splash pad safety surface. The new multi-use building will be more centrally located to the park and splash pad, in addition to having washrooms and a concession stand with a pavilion. At the west end of the park, we are adding bocce ball and a putting green, for multi-generational recreation. The multipurpose trail that encircles the site perimeter will now feature outdoor sports and fitness equipment to support active lifestyles.

The new development has a project budget of just over \$1 million. Hibernia Park Phase II will be funded by the OSLAD grant and the New Lenox Community Park District. When OSLAD grants are awarded, agencies typically exceed the dollar for dollar minimum matching requirement. On average, local agencies match the state's dollar investment by \$1.75, meaning that the state receives 175% of its investment.

OSLAD 2021 Submission

The New Lenox Community Park District is one of 87 agencies throughout the state to receive an OSLAD grant. A total of \$30.3 Million dollars was awarded to agencies. Funding for this round of OSLAD grants was the direct result of Illinois Association of Park District's (IAPD) advocacy efforts. Without the support of the IAPD membership, these OSLAD grants would not have been possible.

"We are thrilled to receive this grant that will allow us to expand and update the current recreational amenities while creating something new for residents," New Lenox Community Park District Executive Director Greg Lewis said. "The planned additions will appeal to our entire community making Hibernia Park truly a destination site for New Lenox."

The remainder of the fees are then divided into eight equal monthly payments. All payments are due on the 15th of the month, beginning September 15. - 4. You must sign up for our automatic payment plan, exception is if you pay in full. You must complete these forms and submit them at the time of registration. You will be subjected to a \$25.00 Service Charge if your card is declined.
- 5. If you pay your full tuition payment at time of registration, the \$50 non-refundable registration fee will be waived.

The New Lenox Community Park District offers shelter rentals at several park sites, all of which are developed with playground equipment! Residents and nonresidents can rent the Park Shelters shown below.

Rentals for 2023 Began on Tuesday, January 3, 2023.

Park Shelter Rental costs include use of electric and shelter rental. Please remember that these are public parks and open space will remain open to the public. In order to be approved to bring in an inflatable (no water inflatables allowed; for a full list of prohibited items please visit newlenoxparks.org) onto Park District property; you MUST supply a Certificate of Insurance (COI) by Operating Vendor with a \$1,000,000.00 policy; naming the New Lenox Community Park District as additional insured with 701 W. Haven Avenue, New Lenox, IL 60451 as the address and include a copy of the vendor's permit to conduct business. Once the COI and Business Permit is received the renter will be allowed to have the inflatable on Park District property; this MUST be supplied prior to your event. These documents may be mailed to the Park District address above or faxed to (815) 485-3589 with ATTN: Park Rentals.

- Park Rentals are available from Apr. 15-Oct. 31
- Hours of Operation: 9:00am-8:00pm
- All parks are ADA accessible
- *A security deposit of \$250 and rental fee is required for all Park Shelter Rentals at time of reservation.

Cancellation policy within the 14-day period prior to the rental date:

- 8-14 days prior: Security deposit is retained. The rest will be refunded within a period of 30 days.
- 7 days or less: Security deposit plus 50% of the rental fees will be retained. The other 50% will be refunded to the signee within a period of 30 days.
